In the rare case that your child has not informed you, the STEAM Magnet will be conducting a Science Fair for all students in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Many of our students participated in this activity last year and are eager to participate again.

We are sending this message to all parents so that you can be a source of support for our students as they engage in this project. We have laid out a timeline for the entire process, including dates.

**Important Dates:** 

9/13/21 – Science Fair Proposal forms due

9/20-24/21 - Proposal forms returned to students. Proposal was either given a "go ahead" or students were asked to provide further detail and/or discuss this with their teacher. Please check Schoology grades to see the status of your child's proposal or ask them to see the form.

\*10/2/120 – Abstracts due on Schoology: 1 paragraph summary of their project.

\*10/16/20 – Introduction due on Schoology: 3 paragraphs on science concepts incorporated in their project

\*Students will be working with their English teacher on proper formatting for both the abstract and the introduction to the project. These two components will be for a grade in both English and Science.

11/6/20 – Procedure due on Schoology: Step by step procedure on lab experiment

12/4/20 - Data due on Schoology

12/18/20 - Results and Conclusion due on Schoology

1/22/21 -Science Fair projects due.

It is not our intent to have students working on this over their 3 week holiday break; therefore we have broken up the due dates throughout fall semester.

Students will be submitting their poster, 3-minute video, and journal<sup>\*\*</sup> on 1/22. Judging will take place the week of 1/25/21. Winners will be announced at the end of the week.

\*\*Although keeping a journal is optional, it is one of the L.A. County Science Fair's requirements. Those students who qualify for participation in the L.A. County Science Fair will need to present a journal.
