4. State the hypothesis using an “if...then ...” statement.
5. What are the variables? What are your controls?
6. What were your significant findings? (results)
7. Explain the results of your experiment and relate it to the problem statement/ hypothesis. Does your data support or reject your hypothesis?
8. Did your results match your research? Did any errors occur? Did you have any discrepant events? (Weird results that didn't fit the trend?)
9. Tell us how your project can benefit others or how it can apply to a real life situation.
10. What further experiments might you now be interested in doing?
